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





Certification Timeline Changes

MY2020-MY2021: Released 7/1/2020

- MY2020:
 - Followed "normal" certification timeline
 - Updates released 10/1/2020; all measures certified by 2/15/2021
- MY2021:
 - Final specification updates: 3/31/2021
 - Certification of all measures and systematic sampling: 10/1/2021
 - Certification of survey sample: 12/15/2021

MY2022: Will be released 8/1/2021

- Will follow new certification timeline
- Final specification updates: 3/31/2022
- Certification of all measures and systematic sampling: 7/1/2022





MY2021 Measure Updates

Retired Measures:

- Disease Modifying Anti-Rheumatic Drug Therapy for Rheumatoid Arthritis
- Enrollment by State
- Total Membership
- Childhood Immunization Status (Combo rates 2, 4, 6, 8, & 9)
- Plan All Cause Readmissions: 18-64 Medicare Skilled Nursing Facility reporting
- Enrollment by Product Line: Binary gender stratifications



MY2021 Measure Updates

- Comprehensive Diabetes Care (Admin numerator change)
- Pharmacotherapy Management of COPD Exacerbation (- bronchodilator)
- Use of Imaging Studies for Low Back Pain (req'd exclusions)
- Use of Opioids at High Dosage (several +/- medications)
- Plan All Cause Readmissions



Key Considerations for MY2021

- Survey and Audit Timelines are Unchanged
- Develop a plan for prospective data runs
- Assess the need to update your contract based on the certification timeline changes
- Talk with your auditor about the plan for reviewing preliminary rates
- Use supplemental data in prospective measure calculations to anticipate rate improvements



Best Practices and Strategies

Work Closely with Your HEDIS Certified Vendor:

- Communicate changes to claims, provider, enrollment or other systems
 - Review data mapping and logic changes
 - Review changes to data sources
- Review custom or state reporting requirements, including survey reporting



Best Practices and Strategies

Medical Record Review (MRR) Project

- Review your chase logic to identify opportunities for improvement
- Assess reports to:
 - Ensure you have the information needed to manage the day-to-day project
 - Report to senior leadership
- Review chart retrieval and abstraction tool configuration for process improvement
- Assess the impact of COVID on your MY2020 project



Best Practices and Strategies

Supplemental Data

- Assess potential new supplemental sources in collaboration with your HEDIS-certified vendor and auditor
 - Identify key tasks to support use of new source for HEDIS
 - Gather documentation, file formats, mapping, additional IT resources
 - Initiate Roadmap Section 5
 - Discuss potential mapping or logic changes to support intake of data
 - Conduct internal PSV to ensure data meets audit criteria
 - Develop testing plan in partnership with your HEDIS-certified vendor

Continued evaluation of strategy and timeline for electronic data submission for HEDIS

Comprehensive Diabetes Care: Stand alone measures A1c control, eye exam and blood pressure
